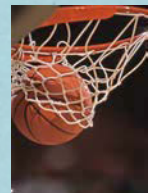

The Tok Middle School Technology class has been busy finishing up multimedia projects about the United States and now - earthquakes! Students have been using techniques in iMovie to create stop-motion and green screen movies. The green screen studio in Ms. Weisz's room, now known as "Hollywood" has been getting a lot of use as students have transported themselves by green screen backgrounds to underwater coral reefs, the mountain tops of Colorado, and the oil fields of Alaska. Students are now working on a multimedia project about earthquakes in which they'll be using interactive maps, spreadsheets and graphs, and yet more green screen movies.
